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COLONOSCOPY PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS PEG 3350/TRILYTE/COLYTE/NULYTELY

ONE WEEK BEFORE PROCEDURE

Stop taking iron supplements, fish oil and vitamins containing iron

TWO DAYS BEFORE PROCEDURE

Do not eat cabbage, corn, beans, lettuce, seeds and nuts. Stop taking bulk forming agents such as Metamucil, Fibercon, Konsyl and Colon Care capsules.

ONE DAY BEFORE PROCEDURE: Start on a clear liquid diet in a.m. after a light breakfast (example: eggs,toast, coffee) Drink 8 ounces of clear liquid every hour. ** *Be sure to mix bowel prep according to directions on the container and refrigerate 2-12 hours prior to 6:00 p.m.

LIOUIDS ALLOWED:

Regular or decaffeinated tea or coffee, any clear carbonated beverages (ex: sprite, ginger ale), Gatorades and sports drinks (no red or pulple) fruit juices allowed: apple, cranberry, grape, cranapple (red cranbeny is ok), Jell-O, NO RED -DO NOT ADD FRUIT OR VEGTABLES), Popsicles, (PLAIN, NOT CREAMY OR FRUITY, NO RED), broth or bouillon.

6:00 p.m. ** *drink 8 oz of prep solution every 15 minutes until about ¹/2 of solution is consumed.*** Place remainder of solution into the refrigerator 9:00 p.m. drink 8 oz .of a clear liquid of your choice. 10:00 p.m. drink 8 oz. of a clear liquid of your choice.

DAY OF COLONOSCOPY:

NO SOLID FOOD and NO ALCOHOL

* *Beginning 5 hours before your scheduled procedure time, drink the remaining bowel prep solution. Drink 8 oz. of solution every 15 minutes until the remainder of the solution is consumed.**

You may continue to drink clear liquids until 3 hours before your scheduled procedure time.

You should take your heart medications (excluding Plavix, Coumadin, Eliquis and Pradaxa), blood pressure medications and medications for lung problems on the day of the exam with a sip of water. All other medications should not be taken until after procedure.

******Prescribed Blood thinning medications need to instructed.(warfarin, Coumadin, Pradexa, Plavix and X		prior to procedure unless otherwise
*** ***DIABETICS take HALF your normal dose the	e day before your procedure	and NONE the day of procedure.
*** *Please let office know if you have had a cardiac s ***You may continue taking aspirin and aspirin produ taking prednisone, methotrexate or enbrel.

You MUST have a driver for the procedure. You MA	Y NOT drive yourself.

TIPS FOR IMPROVED BOWEL PREP		
** *Bowel prep solutions taste best well-chilled.		
***You may add Crystal Light (NO RED) or tea bag t		
** *Drink the whole dose quickly rather than sipping small amounts. ** *If lukewarm liquids are preferred, remove the dose from refrigerator 15-30 minutes before drinking.		
** *Rinse mouth with water, clear soda or mouthwash after drinking.		
** *Suck on hard candy or lollipops (NO RED OR PURPLE). Suck on lemon drops to reduce nauseous feeling.

*** Apply diaper rash cream/zinc oxide liberally after each trip to bathroom.
